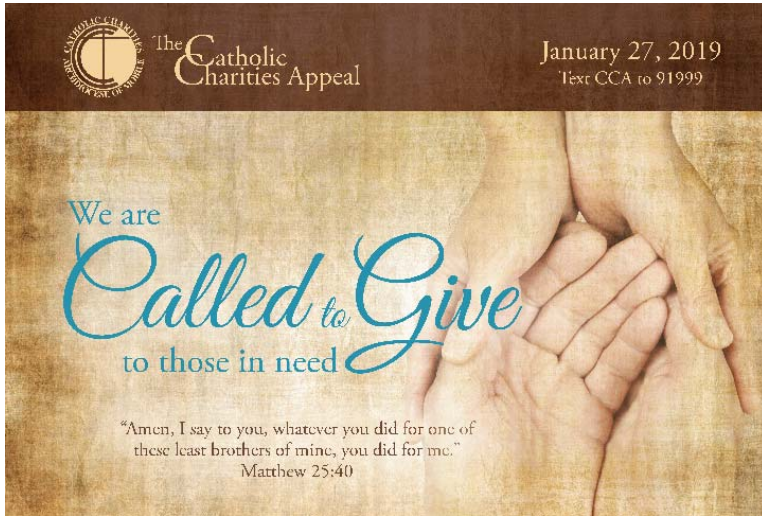

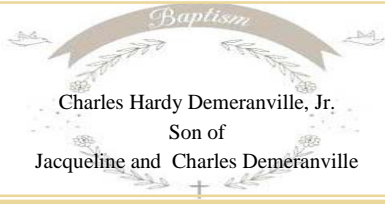

10AM Mass

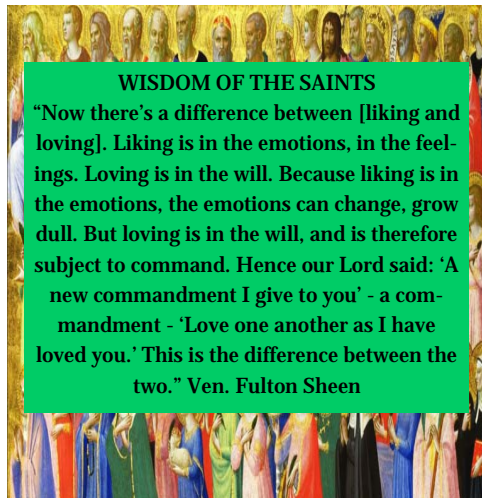
