St. Ignatius Parish will celebrate the Third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, with more than just the rose candle this year. On this day which means REJOICE, we are also adopting the Vatican tradition of blessing Nativity scene figures of the Baby Jesus ("Bambinelli" in Italian). The tradition was started by Pope Paul VI in 1969 and ever since, the Bambinelli blessing has been given by the Pope in St. Peter's Square on the Third Sunday of Advent. It's a teachable moment for families to refocus on the true meaning of the Advent and Christmas season.

We ask every household in our parish, young and old, to unpack your creche and bring the Baby Jesus from your family's Nativity scene to church to be blessed at any Sunday Mass on the weekend of December 15-16 2018, the Third Sunday of Advent.
