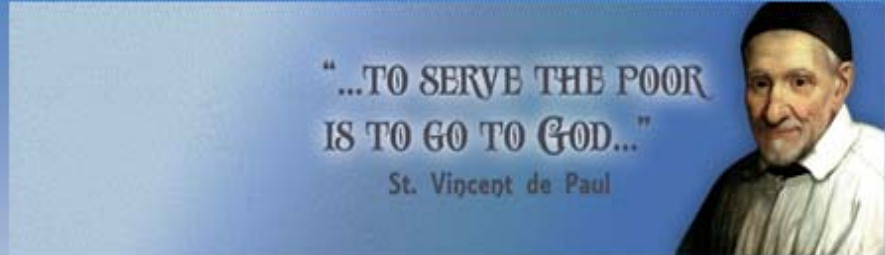

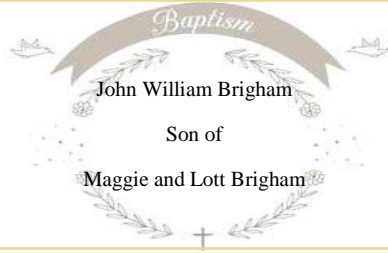
I am grateful to Penelope house for our time there, but more thankful to you for helping us get in our own apartment. We just found a new church home, too! I'm so excited
