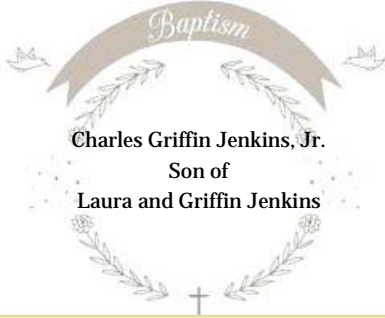

*The Sunday after Easter is **Divine Mercy Sunday!***

How should we prepare for this great feast day?



In the year 2000, Saint John Paul II officially declared the Sunday after Easter to be **"Divine Mercy Sunday."** This was based on revelations of Christ to St. Faustina in the 1930s. You can read about these visions in the *Diary of St. Faustina*.

Jesus told St. Faustina that this Feast of Mercy would be a very special day when **"all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened"**(Diary 699).

Jesus promised that **"The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment"** (Diary 699). He went on to say **"I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy"** (Diary 1109).

We encourage everyone to take advantage of this incredible promise of a **plenary indulgence**. Be sure your children understand the conditions for a plenary indulgence: confession, communion, prayers for the Pope's intentions, and detachment from sin.

The Church allows for us to go to Confession for up to 20 days, before or after Divine Mercy Sunday, in order to meet the conditions of the plenary indulgence.

Here at St. Ignatius Parish, we will celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy at all the Masses on Sunday, April 28.

We will pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy right before Mass. (Confessions also available before Mass.)

Join us for an outside reception after 10 a.m. Mass to welcome our newest Catholics, received into full communion at the Easter Vigil.
