See you Tuesday morning.

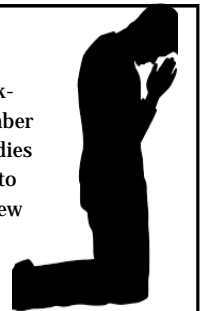

The rectory will be closed on September 3rd in observance of the Labor Day Holiday. We will have an 8AM Mass but no 6:15AM Mass on September 3rd.

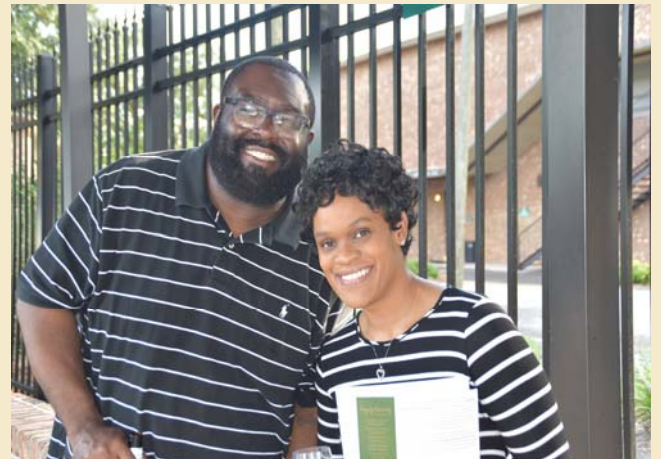
PREIST BURSE CLUB
